The foundation was formed in 2006 after youngest son, Bobby, died in a car accident on February 11 of that year. He was a passenger in a single car rollover accident in which he died instantly.

Bobby was 18 years old and was going to graduate from North Canyon High School in May 2006. Bobby was neither a star athlete nor a great scholar. He was a young man who had a talent for making everyone around him feel better. He had a quick and infectious smile that made everyone who met him feel at home. He was as comfortable speaking with 6 year olds as well as 70 year olds. Bobby also had a tremendous love for athletics. He watched every game of the Green Bay Packers, Phoenix Suns and Arizona Diamondbacks. He studied the sports page each morning and memorized statistical information about his favorite teams.

The scholarship winner will be interviewed and chosen by the Bobby Stark Foundation Board of Directors. The scholarship winner will not be the star athlete nor the greatest scholar. We will present this scholarship to a young individual that needs assistance and is the kind of person that is willing to go out of their way to help others – as Bobby did.

Each year, we plan an event in an effort to increase the scholarship fund to an amount that is self-sustaining and will one-day provide a full-ride scholarship each year.

This year's event is a golf tournament with friends, family and classmates competing for the purpose of raising money for the scholarship fund. The tournament entry fees, tournament sponsors, raffled items and any other donations will all be going to the scholarship fund.
